CONNECT

- 2. Read Matthew 28:18-20. How do these verses apply to followers of Jesus today?
- 3. How is baptism for the believer's benefit?
- 4. How is baptism for the benefit of others?
- 5. Baptism is an outward and visible symbol of salvation. It is not salvation. Why is this distinction important?





BEFORE NEXT TIME

Spend some time this week thinking about the person or people who have had an impact on your faith journey. What about their life seemed different from yours, and how did it impact your own thoughts about faith? If you haven't shared your faith story publicly through baptism, what's holding you back?
